Background

- July 2009. ANAM and UN invite COONAPIP to jointly develop the National Programme (NP)
- October 2009. Policy Board approves funding allocation request for Panama's
- October 2010. UN agencies and ANAM finalize and sign NP document
- <u>February- November 2011</u>. Workplans updated, contracts for technical work and socialization with stakeholders









Background

- <u>January 2012.</u> ANAM dedicates increasing number of personnel to the NP. Activities begin to accelerate
- June 2012. COONAPIP sends first letter of complaint to UN-REDD
- August 2012. High Level Commission (UN Agencies ANAM COONAPIP) and Technical Commission established
- February 2013. COONAPIP withdraws from UN-REDD.
- March 2013. UNREDD suspends new activities and launches an independent investigation & evaluation









Some results reported

- Design phase of <u>forest inventory</u> & updated <u>map of land use</u>
- Mapping of <u>multiple benefits</u> from forest
- Estimation of <u>costs of REDD</u> completed
- Identification of <u>areas at risk</u> of deforestation under different assumptions of development
- "Mesa Nacional REDD" established
- <u>Pilot initiative</u> with the Panama Canal Authority
