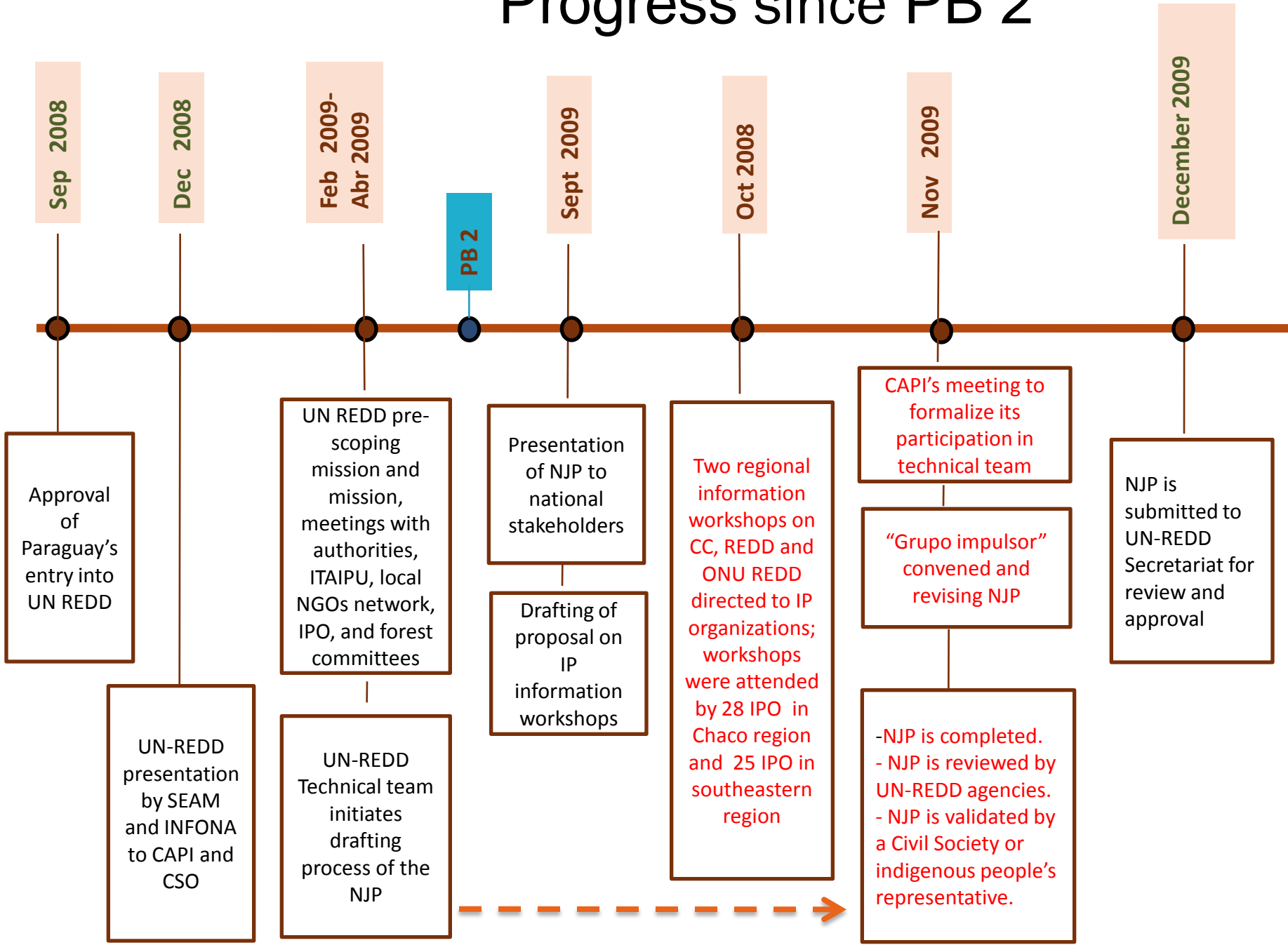

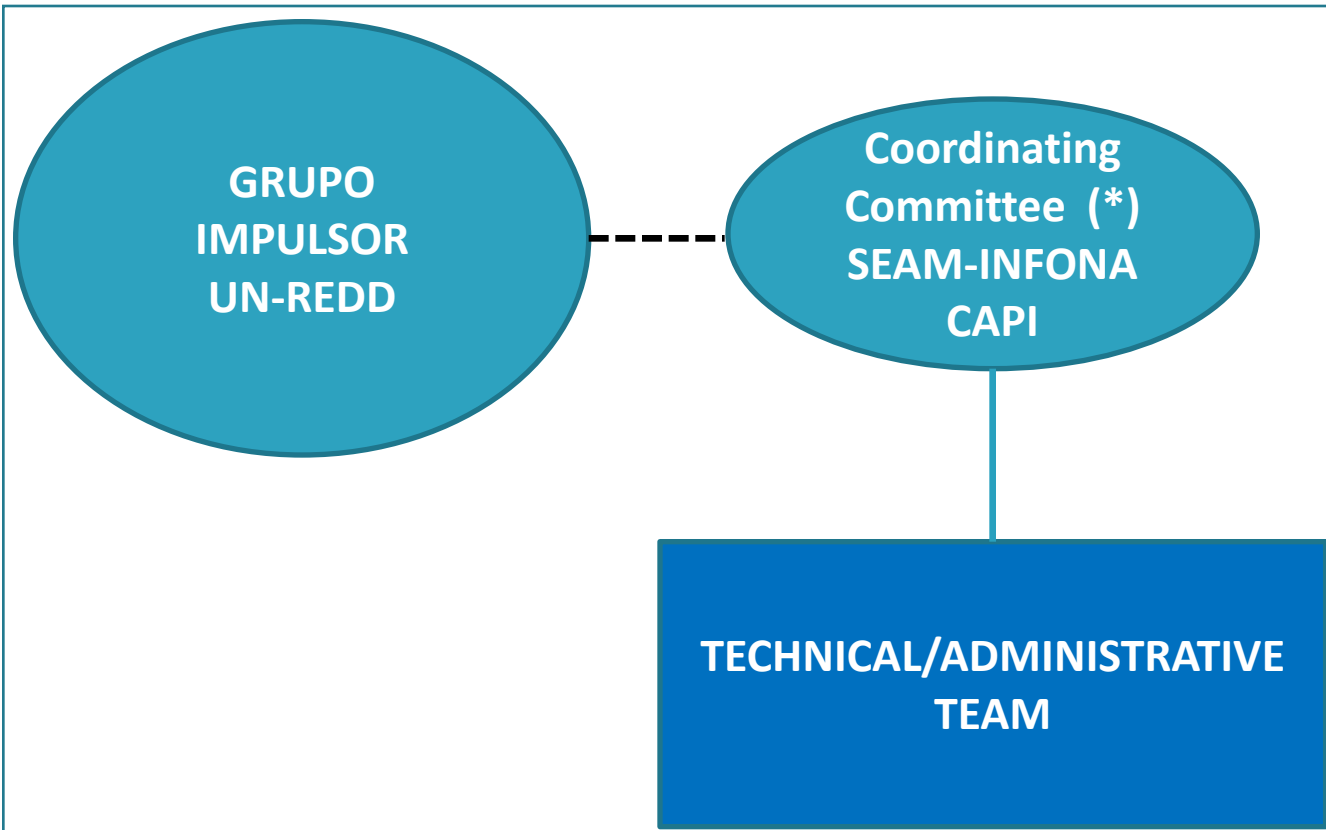
Progress since PB 2
