Go-REDD+ is an e-mail listserver managed by the UN-REDD Programme team in Asia-Pacific, based in Bangkok. The main objective of **Go-REDD+** is to distribute information, synopses of research results and activities related to REDD+ in Asia-Pacific, to assist countries in their REDD+ readiness efforts. As an electronic mailing list, **Go-REDD+** will disseminate relevant information and serve as a node for discussing "hot" topics.

Most of us are very busy. Thus, we intend to only mail out brief messages (usually one page) but with information on where and how additional information on a particular topic can be obtained. On average, two messages a month should reach you.
