Background

- PB7 requested a presentation at PB8 on clarifications regarding procedures for countries to access targeted support within the Global Programme.



Concept

- Demand-driven specific support under one or more of the UN-REDD Programme six work areas.
- Small-scale, demand-driven, and technical or advisory in nature and to be provided to countries by the participating UN agencies in response to country needs.
- Designed to address specific gaps or needs of countries that have developed or are in the process of developing a National REDD+ strategy.
- All partner countries of the UN-REDD Programme are eligible to receive targeted support, subject to the availability of funds and the programming priorities of the work areas



Procedures

1. Can be requested by partner countries with efforts to prepare a national REDD+ strategy or action plan, including those with National Programmes.
2. Scoped within any of the six work areas defined in the UN-REDD Strategy and represent additional contribution to national REDD+ efforts with a view to fill gaps.



Procedures

3. Requests should be presented by partner countries, in coordination with the agencies' teams and the Resident Coordinator, to the UN-REDD Secretariat.

Requests for backstopping of National Programmes can be sent directly to the participating UN agencies.



Procedures

4. The requests will be registered by the UN-REDD Secretariat and forwarded to the agencies' REDD teams for decision on whether the request can be met, based on:
 - Consistency with the objectives of the UN-REDD Programme
 - Potential contribution to national REDD+ efforts
 - Participating agencies' availability of technical and financial resources
 - Alignment with the agencies' programming priorities for the relevant work areas



Procedures

5. The agencies will communicate directly with the countries on the targeted support requests and will report on the agreements reached through the Secretariat.
